

## Best Practices in Graduate Supervision

- Find out as much as possible about your potential supervisor's work and supervision style.
- 2 Participate cooperatively and responsibly in the supervisory relationship. Understand that graduate supervision is a shared responsibility.
- Develop a realistic timeline for your program with your supervisor, and review it often.
- Have regular meetings with your supervisor, and at least one meeting annually with your supervisory committee.
- Keep your supervisor informed of emerging issues that may affect your academic progress.

- 6. Be proactive by contacting Accessibility Services for disability and related barriers.
- 7. If needed, seek counselling to maintain your mental health and well-being.
- Seek conflict resolution as early as possible. Consider contacting the <u>Centre</u> <u>for Graduate Mentorship and</u> <u>Supervision</u> for advice.
- Inform yourself about the spectrum of resources available on campus that can support you in completing your program.
- Become familiar with program-specific and University-wide policies and regulations that may affect your program completion.
